At Baumberger, we know that sometimes things don't go as planned and some classes are more difficult than others; this is why we have a policy of paying regular stipends to scholars on probation with the sincere hope that things, both personal and scholastic, will improve in the months ahead. The 2012 Fall Semester was an extremely tough one for some of our scholars. Regretfully, three students failed to meet the probation requirements and have been terminated, two students have been placed on Scholastic Probation for passing fewer than 12 hours, 16 students have been placed on Progress Probation for failure to make a minimum 2.0 GPA, and 15 students have been placed on both Progress and Scholastic probation. We know each of you will do your very best to meet your probation requirements!

Renewal Update

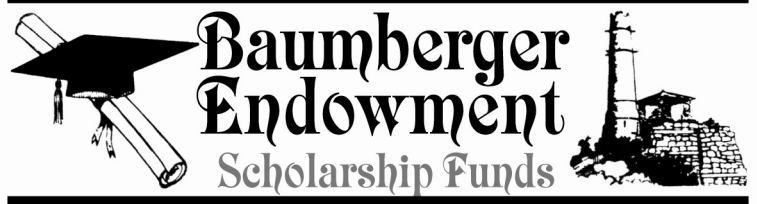
