In Memoriam

Stanley H. Schmidt 1916-2015

On March 10, 2015, Mr. Stanley H. Schmidt, who served as Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Baumberger Endowment from 1979-1997, passed away at age 98.

Stanley, a native San Antonian, graduated from the University of Texas with a degree in marketing. He was a leader in his church, a great student of history and a fine musician. He loved people, education, his family and the outdoors. Stanley served in the Army Air Corps in WWII. He was the former president of SA Portland Cement Co., where he worked for "Mr. Charlie" Baumberger for over 30 years, starting as an accounting clerk.

Under Stanley's leadership, he and four other trustees formed the Baumberger Endowment in 1979, to honor Mr. Baumberger's wishes to provide scholarship funds for "Texas boys and girls in the basic arts and sciences," allowing graduates of Bexar County High Schools to attend state and non-denominational colleges and universities in the State of Texas. During his 27 years of active service to the Baumberger Endowment's Board of Trustees, Stanley served as Chairman, Secretary, and Member, before being named as Trustee Emeritus in 2006.

Stanley was the great historian of the Endowment and always had a story to tell. He will be remembered for his enthusiasm in carrying out the dream of Mr. Baumberger.

Stanley was preceded in death by two wives, and is survived by his son, daughter, five grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. Stanley's son, Ronald S. Schmidt, is the current Chairman of the Board of Trustees here at the Baumberger Endowment.

Renewal Update
